

Anchorage Historic Preservation Commission
Minutes from Regular Meeting
June 16, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Bill Wetherton. Commission members in attendance were Becky Miller, Bill Wilkinson, Clyde Ensor, Tony Bayus, Dan Fultz and advisors Peg Revell, Cindy Parrish, and Mildred Ewen. Visitors included Stuart Ray, Carol Shutt, and Kristin Wilson.

The minutes were corrected to change the spelling of Harper Fowley. The agenda was read.

Carol Shutt, 12100 Ridge Road, requested approval to change previously approved garage doors. The new doors will be solid with no windows. Miller moved for approval, Bill Wilkinson seconded and the motion carried. The Shutts also requested to change the passage door to solid steel. The arched transom with glass windows will remain the same and the door will have no other windows. Bayus moved for approval; Wilkinson seconded and all approved.

Anchorage Trails, represented by Stuart Ray and Kristen Wilson, requested approval for nine marker posts along the trails that will not be seen from the roads. The 6 x 6 wood posts with branding iron logos will be set 30" below ground. It was recommended that the homeowners of the properties involved give approval. Wilkinson moved for approval, Ensor seconded and all approved.

Miller led a discussion for suggested changes to the Guidebook. This work will continue. Additional means of informing new residents of the Guidebook were also discussed.
