

Anchorage Historic Preservation Commission
Minutes from Regular Meeting

August 16, 2016

Chairman Bill Wetherton called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Commission members in attendance were Clyde Ensor, BJK Elliott, Becky Miller, Bill Wilkinson, Dan Fultz and Doug Schmitt. Visitors included John Waller, Phillip Kash, Curtis Thrush, Katie Greene, Stephanie Robertson, and Kelly Ransdell.

The minutes were read and approved. The agenda was read.

Anchorage Public School, 11400 Ridge Rd., requested approval for window replacement. Following the school's previous visit to the commission's meeting, members were asked to tour the school grounds to view the complexity of the project. One hundred seventy one (171) windows will eventually be replaced and there are several types of windows currently. The proposed windows are of like kind to those on the building, but will be a commercial grade and therefore better quality. The original windows in the front of the historic building will never be replaced; they will be repaired if necessary. Wilkinson moved for approval and Schmitt seconded. The motion carried.

Debbie and Michael Simon, 12106 E. Osage Rd., requested approval for outside light fixture replacement and to refurbish light posts/columns. Builder, Waller, explained that a cast concrete dome cap will be added to the existing columns. He presented one of the large, round globes that will become the lights on top. Schmitt moved for approval; Wilkinson seconded. The motion carried.

Miller led a short discussion of several of the proposed changes for Guidebook revision. Each commission member will write a short article for the City of Anchorage newsletter, in a column to be titled, "Pillars of Preservation."

The meeting adjourned at 7:15.
