

**ANCHORAGE
FORESTRY BOARD
MEETING**

May 4, 2009

Attendees: Mike Brewer, Sally Wilson, Connie O'Connell, Andrea Hanlon, Jim Williams, Tyleen Stoutt, Ann Stivers, and Nan Schlindwein.

The meeting was called to order by Jim Williams at 9:41 a.m.

Minutes: The April minutes were approved.

Budget: The budget report will be presented next month.

Calendar Project: Ann recently spoke with Bill Wooldridge. He has been getting good photos from residents for the 2010 Forestry Board calendar. A digital picture frame has been set up in the reception area at City Hall that rotates photos he has collected for the calendar. He asked that City Hall sends out e-mail reminders periodically and that photo requests be included in each ANCHOR AGE until October.

Canopy Campaign: Connie reported that the Canopy Campaign went well and 105 trees have been planted. She received no complaints from residents though one homeowner failed to mark the location for their tree and had to pay for the planting. Due to weather conditions there was some delay in getting trees planted. It was suggested that next year e-mail addresses be collected from those purchasing trees and updates be sent as to when plantings will take place.

“The Anchor Age”: Information regarding the photo contest for the calendar will be included in the May “Anchor Age”.

Hazardous Trees: Tyleen reported on two trees in City easements that need to be watched, one a huge Sycamore on the east side of the Old Harrods Creek Road bridge.

Kentucky Tree is working in the City now pruning trees and removing hazardous trees that the City recently bid out.

Arbor Day: Andrea e-mailed the date of Tuesday, September 15 to Diane as a possibility for the Arbor Day program. The program will include an instructional session followed by a walk through the community.

Anchorage Pride: No report.

New Business: Tyleen passed around information about upcoming garden tours in the area.

Mike asked Andrea how forestry appointments were going. She replied that beside the usual, there are many appointments for sewer hook-ups.

Ann informed the board that Bill Shipley recently broken his hip and has been in the hospital.
