

## 2018 HAZARDOUS TREE REMOVAL SPECIFICATIONS

- ① Propose your best unit price per tree for complete removal including debris, the stump, and its grindings.
- ① All logs must be removed at the end of the day they are cut down.
- ① Grindings must be removed within 48 hrs. of stump grinding.
- ① Successful bidder must provide "Tree Work Ahead" signs to City prior to starting contract work.
- ① Signage must be in place at all tree work locations.
- ① If roadway is to be closed during tree work, "Detour" signs and "Road Closed" signs must be in place prior to start of work.
- ① Successful bidder cannot work on roads near the Anchorage Public School from:
  - 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Monday through Friday,
  - 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday,
  - 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Friday.
- ① Successful bidder must notify the City two (2) work-days in advance of beginning work so that City can notify residents in the area of tree removal.

- ① All work must be completed within 30 days of starting date, weather permitting.
- ① Successful bidder will be required to show evidence of adequate workers' compensation and liability insurance by supplying the City with a certificate of insurance naming the City co-insured.
- ① Sealed bids are due by Noon on Friday, December 1, 2017, at Anchorage City Hall, 1306 Evergreen Road, Anchorage, KY 40223.
- ① Bid must be sealed and clearly marked "Hazardous Tree Removal Bid" on the outside.
- ① Bids will be presented to City Council for approval at the public meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, December 11, 2017, at Anchorage City Hall.
