ORDINANCE No. 4, SERIES 2016

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING §153.04(C) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
FOR THE CITY OF ANCHORAGE THAT SETS A SIGN PERMIT REVIEW
FEE FOR SIGNS AND SIGN STRUCTURES WITHIN THE CITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Anchorage has, since the inception of its sign ordinance in 1996, required a permit review fee in the amount of \$20.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is frequently called upon to approve waiver of the sign permit review fee for charitable and civic organizations; and

WHEREAS, the revenue from sign permit review fees is a de minimis portion of the City's annual revenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has deemed it in the public interest of the City to repeal that section of the City's sign ordinance setting and requiring a sign permit review fee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ANCHORAGE,
KENTUCKY, BY AND THROUGH ITS CITY COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. §153.04(C) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Anchorage, that sets a review fee for sign permits, shall be and hereby is repealed in its entirety.
2. As of the effective date of this ordinance, no fee will be charged by the City of Anchorage for the review of an application for a sign permit.
3. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication according to law.
